## Nevada Power Quarterly Electric Base Tariff Energy Rate Change

Effective **April 1, 2008**, Nevada Power Company is adjusting its Base Tariff Energy Rate (BTER) to reflect decreases in energy or purchased power costs the company pays on behalf of its customers. This change will result in a revenue decrease of \$31,374,120. Increases or decreases are passed on dollar-for-dollar, with no profit to the company.

The company makes quarterly BTER filings on February 15, May 15, August 15, and November 15. These adjustments become effective 45 days from the date of filing. Once each year the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada (PUCN) undertakes a full review of these quarterly filings to ensure all adjustments were made in accordance with PUCN regulations.
